

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BABYLON HILL, YEOVIL, COUNTY BOUNDARY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BABYLON HILL, YEOVIL, COUNTY BOUNDARY between Babylon Hill roundabout and the Co-op filling station, a distance of approximately 20 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 April 2021 between 1900 and 0700 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 April 2021.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out mains leak repair in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A30 - A37 - A303 - A371 - A357 - A30
